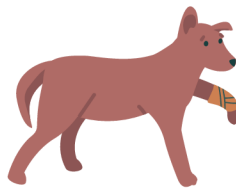
POISON

Seizures, Severe Limp, Unconsciousness



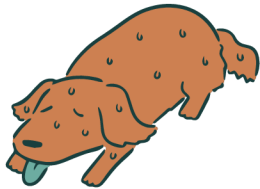
TRAUMA

Bites, Bleeding, Impacts



HEAT

Heat Stroke, Heat Stress



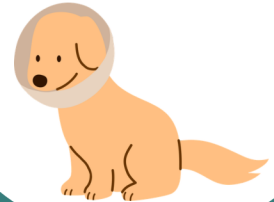
THROAT
